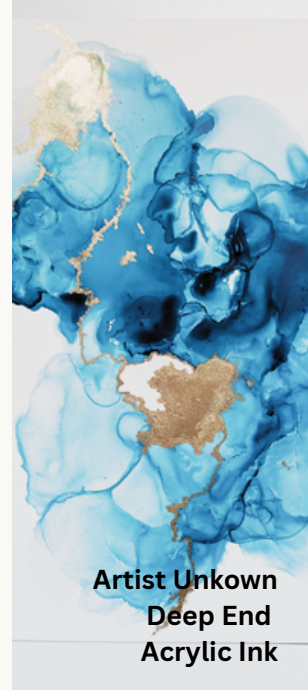

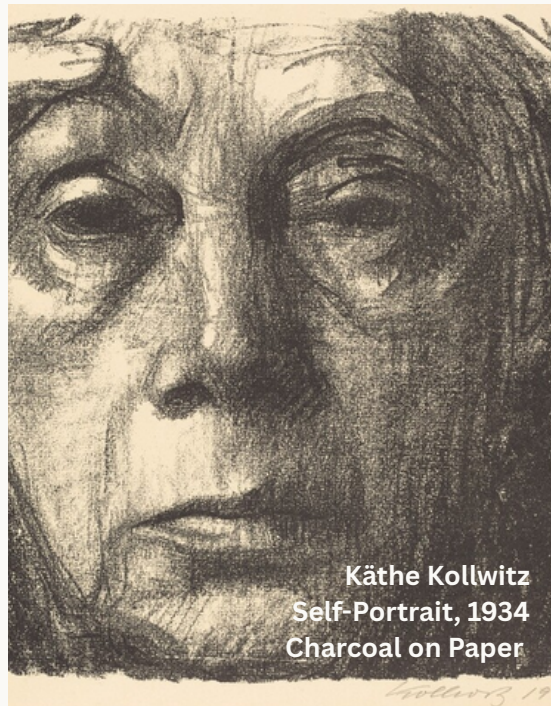


JEWELRY TASTING BOARD

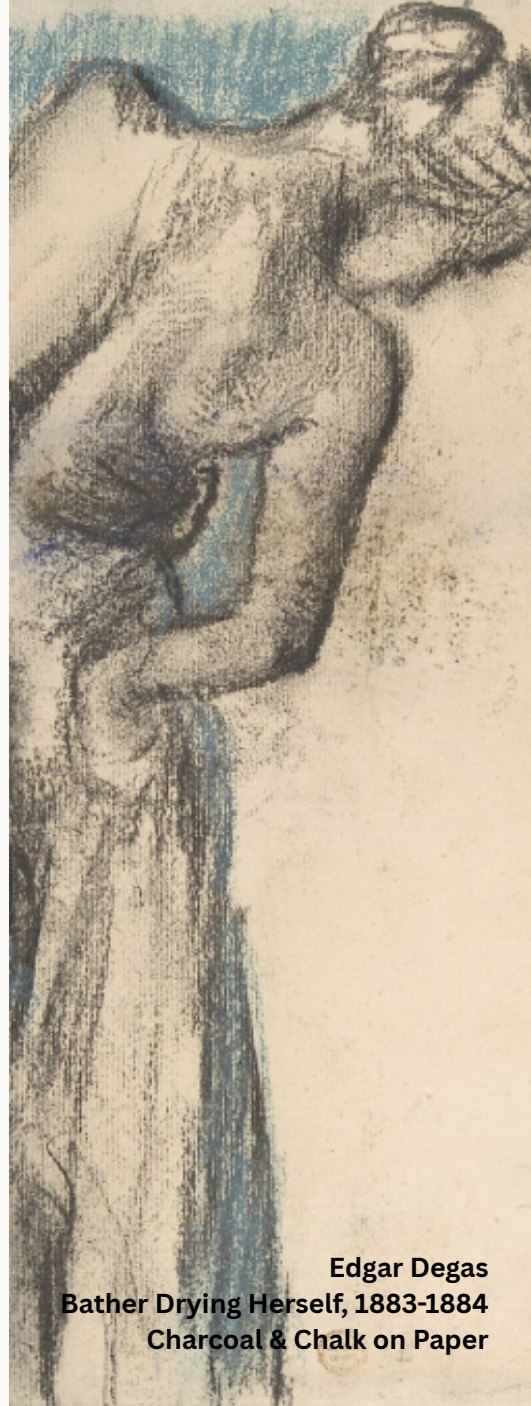

HOMESCHOOL ART LAB

WEDNESDAY - FRIDAY, 11-2 PM

The **Homeschool Art Lab** at **Carolina Arts Café + Studios** combines standards-aligned art education with the freedom, independence, and creative energy of working in a professional art studio.

Students receive two hours of guided instruction each week in a curriculum encompassing the four major areas of visual arts education: **art making**, **art history**, **art criticism**, and **aesthetics**. The program runs for the full academic year, September 1 through May 31, and is designed to provide the depth and rigor equivalent to one academic visual arts credit.

Students have access to the **Homeschool Art Lab Wednesday–Friday, 11 AM – 2 PM** for guided instruction, plus regular studio hours for independent work, project development, and creative exploration.

Each Student Will:

- Receive standards-aligned visual arts instruction.
- Explore drawing, painting, printmaking, mixed media, sculpture, and more.
- Maintain a curriculum binder covering art making, art history, criticism, and aesthetics.
- Have a personal workspace and dedicated studio storage.
- Participate in critiques, independent studio work, and creative exploration.
- Enjoy monthly field trips and artist experiences throughout the community.

AFTERSCHOOL ART CLUB

M-F, 330 - 630 PM

The **Afterschool Art Club** turns afternoons into creative studio time where kids can unwind, explore, and grow as young artists. Each afternoon begins with snacks and outdoor time, weather permitting, followed by one hour of small-group guided visual arts instruction and one hour of independent studio work. Along the way, students learn how a real art studio works—maintaining their own workspace and supplies, managing projects from idea to completion, and developing collaboration, leadership, responsibility, and creative problem-solving skills.

WITH TRANSPORTATION | \$340

We pick up your student at Cayce Elementary, Busbee Creative Arts Academy, or East Point Academy and transport them to the art studios. The monthly subscription includes all school holidays, early release, and winter and spring breaks. \$160 supply fee per semester.

DROP OFF | \$285

You transport your student to and from the art studios daily for creativity and fun. The monthly subscription includes all school holidays, early release, and winter and spring breaks. \$135 supply fee per semester.

ONCE PER WEEK | \$80

You transport your student to and from the art studios once per week for two hours of guided instruction. \$97 supply fee per semester.

DROP-IN | \$50 FULL-DAY | \$25 1/2 DAY

You transport your student to and from the studio. Available for both Afterschool Art Club sessions and when school is closed for any reason.
